



## Sunday of the Publican and Pharisee

*Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom*

*The Typica (Psalms 102 and 145) and the Beatitudes. With the Beatitudes we sing six troparia in the Tone of the week from the Octoechos, and four troparia from Canticle Six of the Canon in the Triodion.*

### Troparion of the Resurrection, tone of the week:

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, tone 3: Unto the Lord let us sinners offer groanings like those of the Publican and let us fall down before Him, as He is Master. For He desireth unto all that repent. For our sake He became incarnate, He Who with the Father is co-unoriginate God.

Both now and ever, and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

Theotokion, tone 3: Today the Virgin stands before us in the church and together with the choirs of saints invisibly prays to God for us. Angels are worshipping with hierarchs, Apostles exult with prophets, for the Theotokos prays in our behalf to the eternal God.

### Prokeimenon, tone of the week:

Epistle: 2 Timothy (3:10-15) pericope 296.

### Alleluia, tone of the week:

Gospel: Luke (18:10-14) pericope 89.

Kinonikon: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. (*Ps.*  
*148:1*)
