



## Sunday of the Prodigal Son

*Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom*

*The Typica (Psalms 102 and 145) and the Beatitudes. With the Beatitudes we sing six troparia in the Tone of the week from the Octoechos, and four troparia from Canticle Six of the Canon in the Triodion.*

### Troparion of the Resurrection, tone of the week:

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, tone 3: Having foolishly abandoned Thy paternal glory, I squandered on vices the wealth which Thou gavest me. Wherefore, I cry unto Thee with the voice of the Prodigal: I have sinned before Thee, O compassionate Father. Receive me as one repentant, and make me as one of Thy hired servants.

Both now and ever, and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

Theotokion, tone 3: Today the Virgin stands before us in the church and together with the choirs of saints invisibly prays to God for us. Angels are worshipping with hierarchs, Apostles exult with prophets, for the Theotokos prays in our behalf to the eternal God.

### Prokeimenon, tone of the week:

Epistle: 1 Corinthians (6:12-20) pericope 135.

### Alleluia, tone of the week:

Gospel: Luke (15:11-32) pericope 79.

Kinonikon: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. (*Ps.* 148:1)
